

Communication – I am Unique

What are we learning?

Learning about what makes us who we are. Why do we look how we do? Why do we dress how we do? Why do we speak how we do? What influences us?

Activities to do at home:

- Draw a self-portrait, look in the mirror – what colour eyes do you have? Hair? Skin? What shape is your face? How big is your nose? Do you wear glasses?
- Ask your grown up for photos of your family members – cut them out and make a collage of everyone that makes up your family. Can you write underneath who they are?
- What sort of clothes do you wear at home? Use materials to cut up and give your self-portrait clothes, can you do the same for each member of your family? Does everyone dress the same?
- Make a list / draw photo of your favourite foods? What types of food do you like?
- Help to cook the meals for your family.
- Where were you born? Colour in the flag of the place in which you were born. Use the computer to find pictures of the place that you were born. Print some photos and cut them out to make a collage to share with others when you come back to school.
- What is the traditional foods from where you were born? Cook some of them with your family.
- What languages can you speak? Make a video of yourself speaking in those languages to share with others when you come back to school. Let's see if anyone at school can work out what you are saying.
- What is the traditional clothing of the place that you were born? Can you try any on? Ask a member of your family to take a photo of you.
