

Numeracy - Sorting and SequencingWhat are we learning?

We are learning to explore patterns and designing items using sequences. We are learning to look at a sequence and anticipate what will come next to repeat the pattern and create an effect. We are also learning to sort items into categories – how do we decide on a category, what belongs and what needs to be removed. This is being applied to real life situations – organising the kitchen, sorting equipment, organising your clothes in the wardrobe.

Activities to do at home:

- Sorting clothes – putting clothes into piles for each person or by type – socks, trousers, tops etc
- Help to unpack the shopping – what goes in the fridge, in the cupboard, on the shelf?
- Sort the lego or duplo bricks - by colour, size, type
- Use the worksheets attached to complete sequence work
- Colour in the shapes and create a sequenced photo frame
