

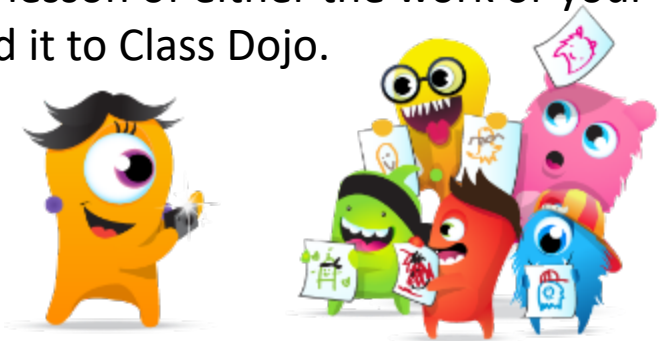


LG3 Remote Learning

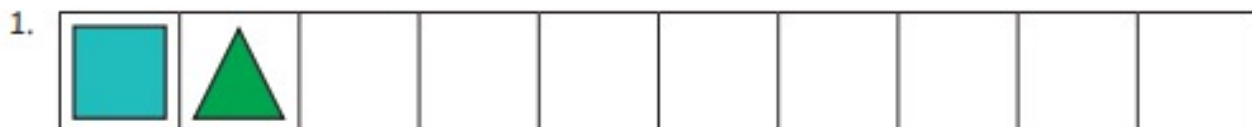
